Check-in time is 1:00PM. Check-out time is 12:00PM. Campers whom choose to check in before 12pm will be charged \$10. Campers whom choose to check out after 3pm will be charged \$10. No Exceptions!

Quiet time is 11:00PM - 8:00AM. Radios must be off at 11:00PM. All exterior lights shall be shut off when you retire for the evening.

Visitors are your responsibility and use the park at their own risk. Visiting hours are over at 11PM.

All motorized vehicles are to be driven by licensed operators only.

Campfires are allowed only in fire rings. Do not leave fires unattended. DO NOT move fire rings. Firewood is for sale at the office.

PLEASE NO TRASH IN FIRE RINGS!

Fireworks are not permitted.

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Any non-swimmer must not be left unattended at the pools. Bathing suits only. Please do not put babies in the pool that are not potty trained or with disposable diapers. Warning - no lifeguard on duty. Everyone swims in pool and pond at their own risk.

Children age 10 and under must be supervised in the restrooms by an adult. Parents or guardians will be held responsible for actions of their children, wards, visitors and themselves. They will also be held financially liable for damage caused by their children or wards. Children (15 years old & under) must be back at their own sites by 10:00PM.

No Glass containers allowed in lodge or pool area.

NO shoes in pool area.

Swim in pond area at your own risk.

Please catch and release when fishing the pond.

MUST have a different bathing suit for pond and pool use.

One family per lot. Each site can have 1 primary unit plus an additional tent. The primary unit can be a trailer, RV, pop-up camper, truck camper, tent, etc.

No more than 2 vehicles at a site. Additional parking is available by the lodge, do not park your vehicle on another campsite. Speed limit is 5MPH.

Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Clean up after your pet. Pets are not permitted in buildings. Do not leave your pet unattended. No noisy pets, please! One picnic tables is provided for each campsite. You may move it anywhere on your site. Please don't move it to another site. Do not deface the tables.

No defacing of property such as trees, buildings, tables, etc. Do not screw of nail things into the trees.

No bows/arrows. No BB Guns, slingshots, paint guns, or other projectile devices of any kind.

No one under the age of 21 is to consume alcohol on Whiskey Creek premises.

Play in playground at your own risk.

Clean your campsite before you check out. Put your trash in a dumpster.

OFF-ROAD VEHICLE RULES

Rider ride at their own risk.

Noisy or inadequately muffled vehicles will not be allowed.

High performance vehicles of any type may not be started within 100 yards of any exterior site or lot of the campground. They must be peddled out and in, before being started. There are no exceptions to this rule.

Unsafe, high speed and "hot dog" riding will not be allowed on any Whiskey Creek property.

No "running around" in the campground or parking lots will be allowed by either adults or children. There is no excuse for not using the trails.

Parents shall supervise their children at all times, children under the age of 8 are not allowed to operate an ATV with out a parent riding along or following behind.

Absolutely no hill climbing will be allowed either up or down hills at Whiskey Creek.

Stay on trails. Do not create new paths.

There will be no off-road vehicle usage of trails designated as X-country ski trails. These trails are designed for hiking when the snow is gone.

The chasing of wildlife on a off-road vehicle is strictly prohibited by Whiskey Creek, Federal, and State Law.

All laws whether State, Federal or local apply to owners use of off-road vehicles at Whiskey Creek.

Unless abused, slow riding (not exceed 13mph) will be allowed on the Whiskey Creek trails. All other speed limits are posted.

"Gunning of machines" and "spinning of tires" will be considered unsafe behavior anywhere on the Whiskey Creek property.

Infractions of these rules will cause suspension of your use of off-road vehicles on Whiskey Creek property for a period of time to be determined by management. Repeated violations will cause permanent suspension.

Parents are responsible for their children's actions - Make sure they know and obey the rules.

Members and campers are responsible for their guests - Make sure they know and obey the rules.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

This Agreement concerns the use of Whiskey Creek property as defined below by persons defined as owners, their invitees or quests.

NO PERSON HAS PERMISSION TO USE OFF-ROAD VEHICLES UPON WHISKEY CREEK PROPERTY, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN.

- 1. Definitions:
- A. "Whiskey Creek Property" includes part of the N 1/2 of Section 30, T17N,R15W, Logan Township, Mason County, Michigan.
- B. "Proprietors" include PV Properties, LLC, Whiskey Creek Management Co., LLC, Daniel R. Posma, Robin Posma, Danielle Viening and Chad Viening.
- C. "Owners" are defined as any persons owning land or interests within the Whiskey Creek property described in paragraph A.
- 2. Permission to Use. Permission is granted by proprietors to any owners, their invitees, or guests, to use off-road vehicles, horses, mules, or any animals which can be ridden, upon Whiskey Creek property, only if an executed Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement is on file with the proprietors. No permission is granted to the

general public to use any of the Whiskey Creek property except as granted in Highway Easement Releases or County road designations.

- 3. Release. The undersigned voluntarily assumes all risks associated with the described in section 2 above. The undersigned owner hereby releases the proprietors, their agents and assigns, from all liability from any or all loss or damage, claim or demands for or on account of injury to the person or property, including acts attributed to the ordinary negligence of the proprietors.
- 4. Indemnification. The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the proprietors, their agents and assigns, from any loss, liability, damage, or cost incurred due to the use of off-road vehicles, horses, mules, or any animals ridden upon Whiskey Creek property by the undersigned, the undersigned's invitees, and quests
- 5. Assumption of Risk. The undersigned assumes full responsibility for any risk of injury, death, or property damage to the undersigned or the undersigned's invitees and guests.
- 6. Inherent Risk. The undersigned acknowledges that the use of off-road vehicles upon Whiskey Creek property is inherently dangerous and involves risk of injury and/or property damage.
- 7. Voluntary Waiver. The undersigned has read and voluntary signs this Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and further agrees that no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreements, have been made.
